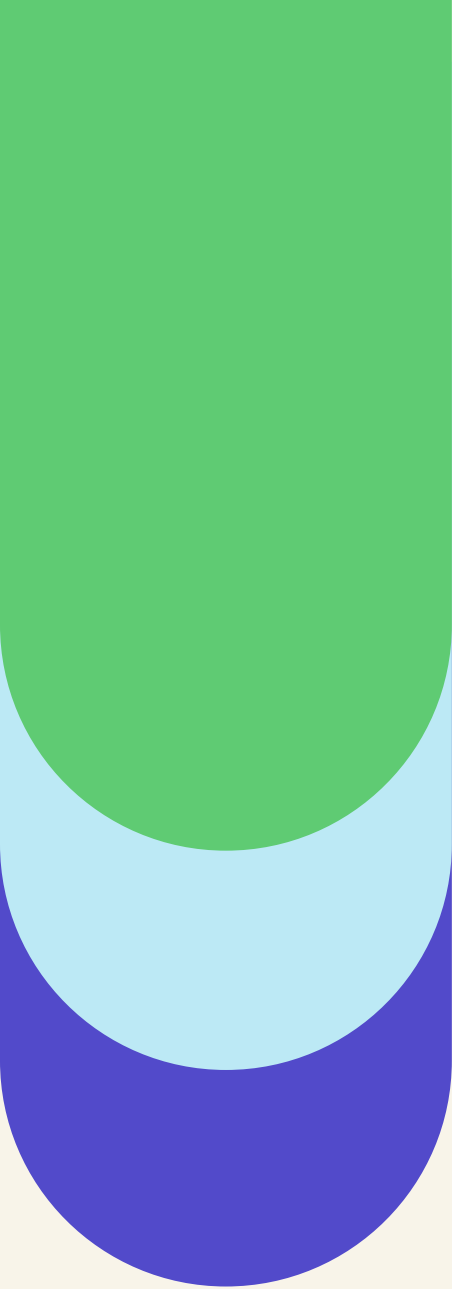

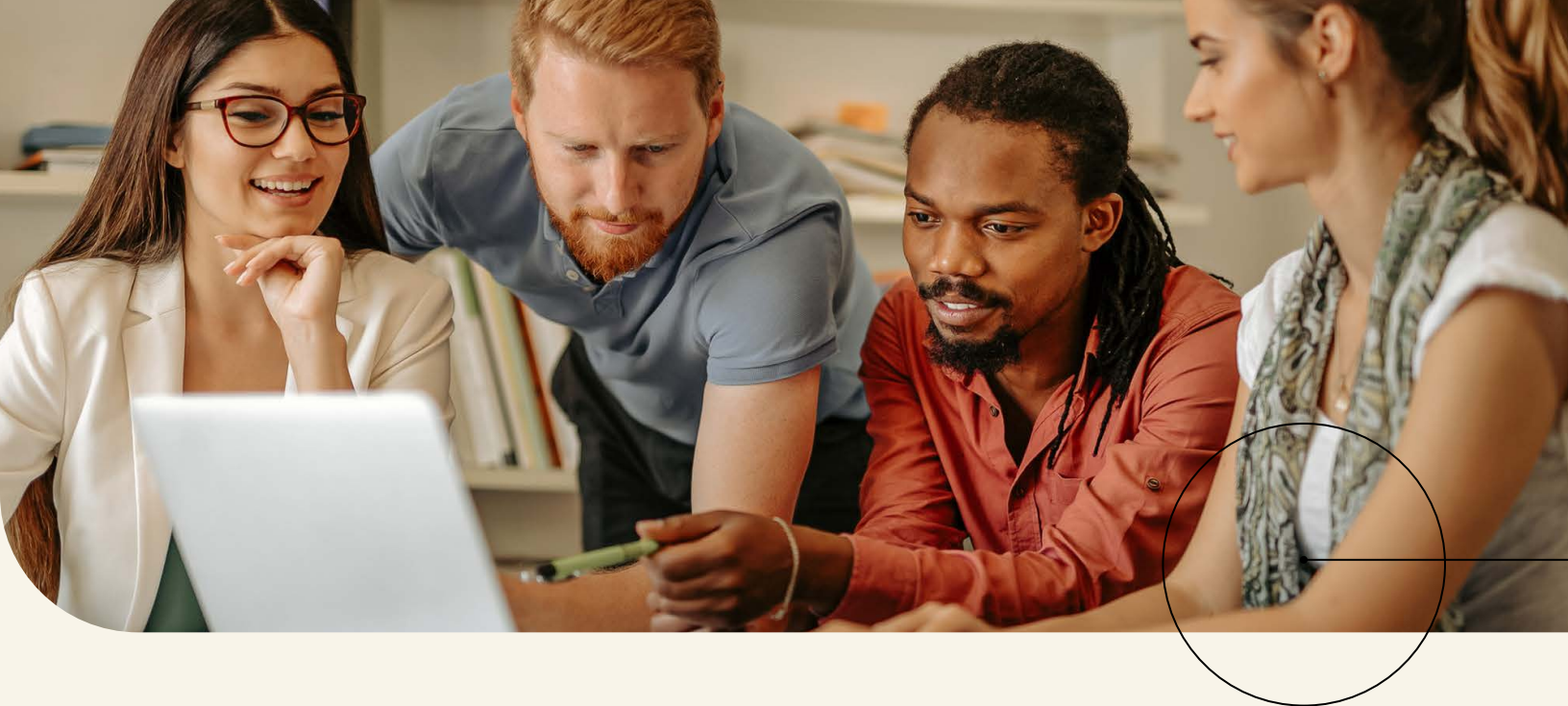

STEP 0

Assess Security, Privacy, and Compliance

Security and privacy are table stakes when considering AI adoption, as AI in schools must be trusted and secure. Many AI tools collect and store user data, but district leaders need to ensure that student information remains protected and that AI decisions are transparent and auditable.

Key Questions to Ask:

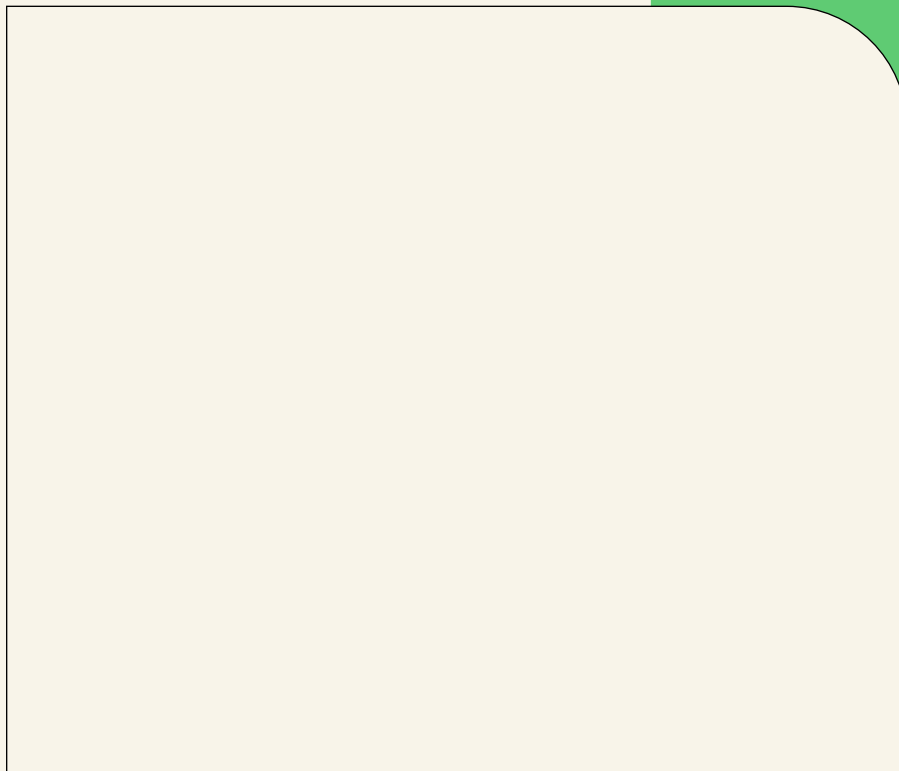
Does the AI vendor comply with key student data privacy laws?

- FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act)
- COPPA (Children's Online Privacy Protection Act)
- SOC 2 Type 2 (Industry-leading security compliance)

How does the AI vendor protect student and staff data?

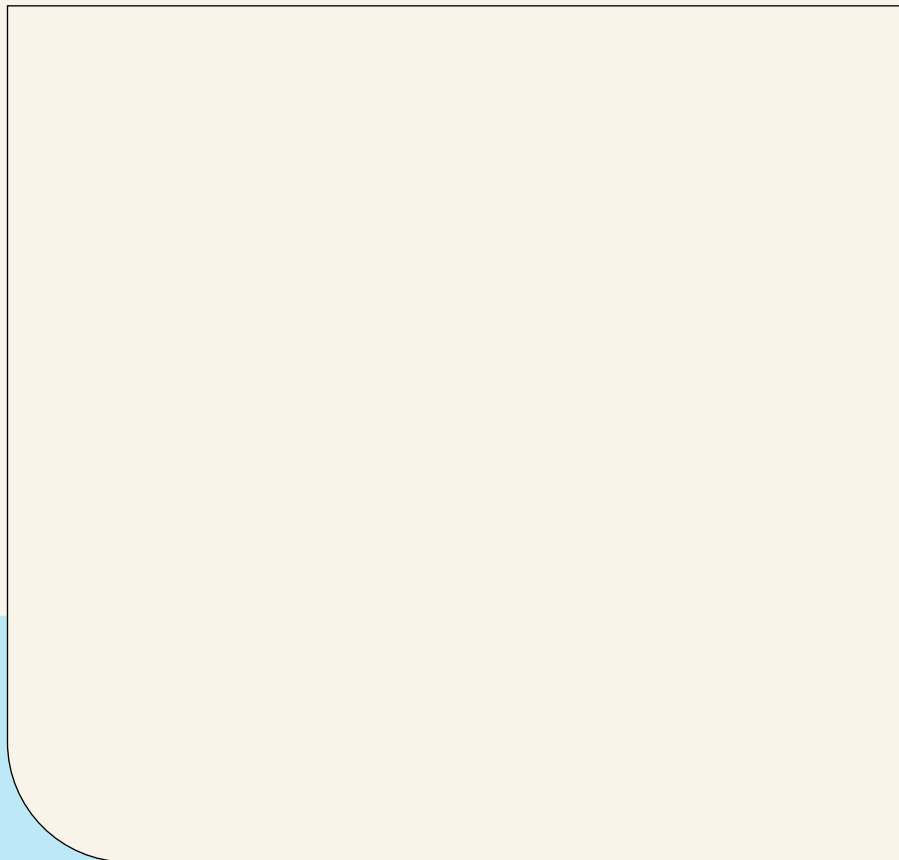
- Is district data used to train AI models? (It shouldn't be!)
- Does the AI tool use encryption and secure authentication? *Note: We strongly recommend for data privacy and security that your school district utilize Single Sign-on and Multi-factor authentication.*
- Does the platform allow for role-based access to ensure data is only available to authorized staff?

Has your technology leader evaluated the vendor's privacy and security agreements and/or terms of service?

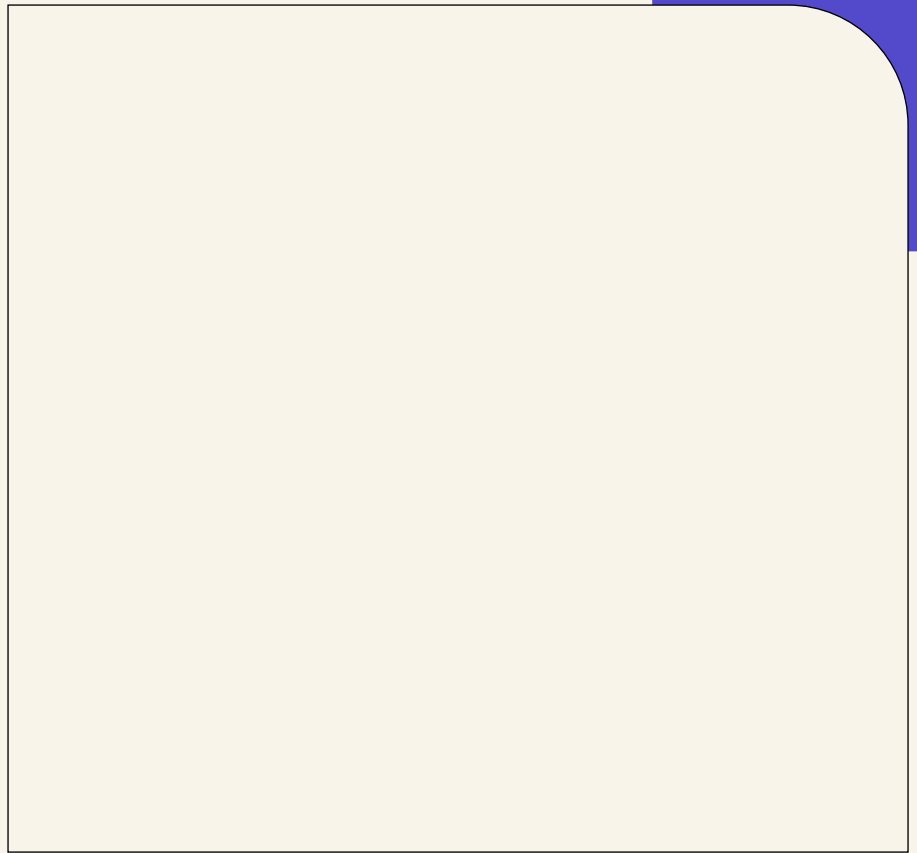


Does the vendor differentiate between security and privacy?

- Security refers to how information is protected (e.g., preventing breaches or unauthorized access).
- Privacy refers to how information is used (e.g., whether student data is being sold or leveraged).



Are we jumping to enable AI features without first considering their impact on teaching, learning, and data security?

STEP 1

Identify District Challenges & Needs

- How are teachers, staff, and students already using AI, whether officially or unofficially?
- Do you know if your AI tools have proper security and permissions setup? Is anyone able to access data they shouldn't be able to?
- Instead of just saying yes or no to AI tools, are we pausing to evaluate how to use them intentionally?



STEP 2

Align AI With Your District's Goals—Not the Other Way Around

When adopting AI, start with your district's priorities rather than letting technology dictate your approach. Identify your biggest challenges and ensure AI solutions are purpose-built to address them

- How are we ensuring transparency about how AI is being used in classrooms and addressing any misconceptions or fears from educators, families, and students?

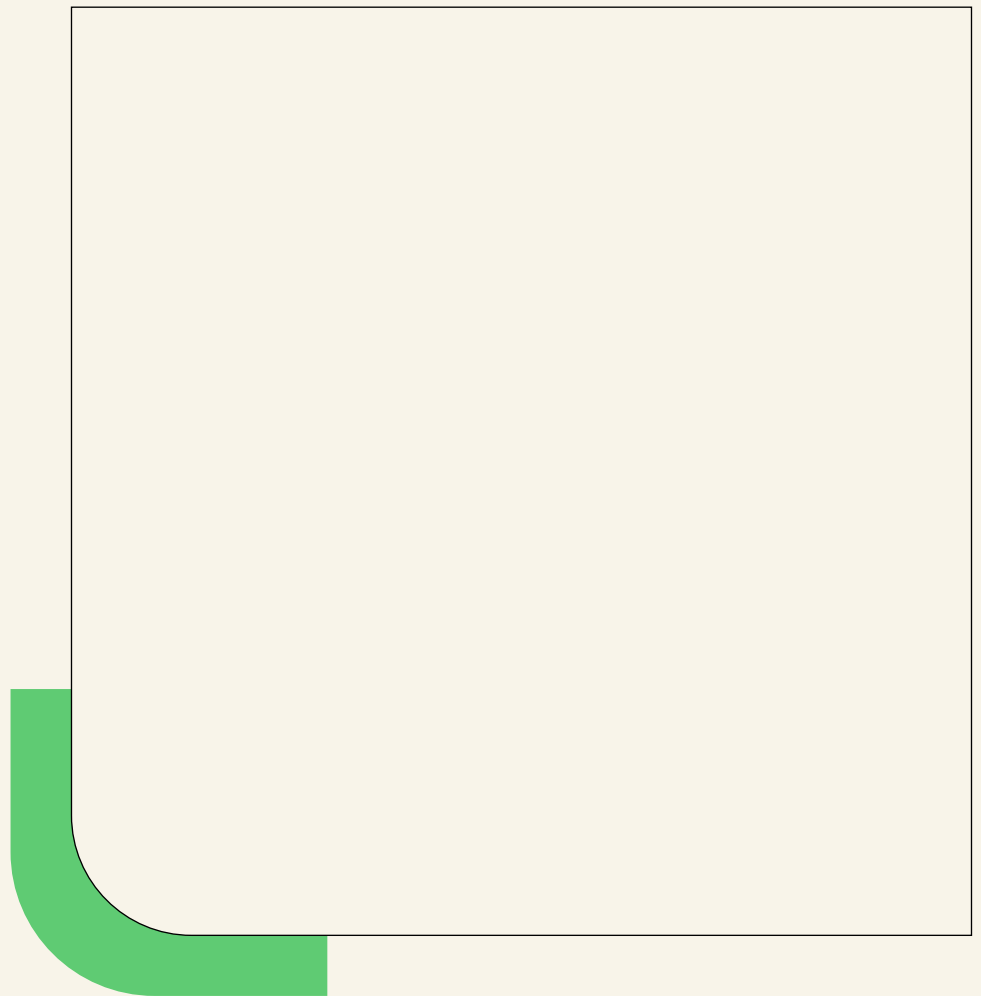
Who will be using AI in our district?

- Students? Will the district implement policies to define approved student usage?



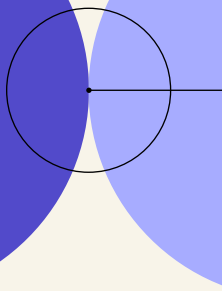

Does the AI tool provide real, research-backed educator support?

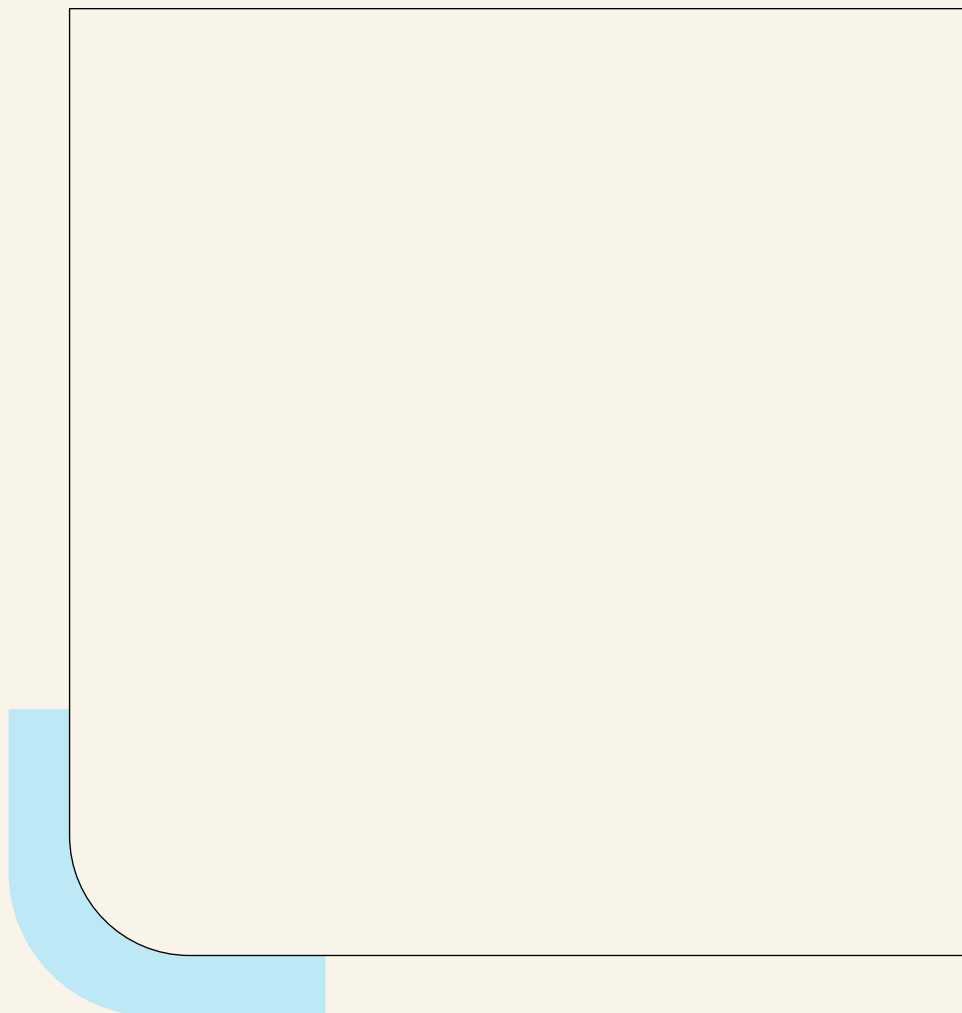
- Does the tool include customizable prompts for personalizing evidence-based interventions?
