STRATEGY: The kindness tree is an easy way for students to express and visualize all of the ways they can be kind!

Instructions:

- 1. Begin by creating a "trunk" of a tree in your classroom or home, taped to a wall, bulletin board, or door.
- 2. Have students brainstorm ways they can be kind to others, or ways they would like others to be kind to them.
- Each student should write their favorite idea on a paper leaf and add it to the tree! Students can add multiple leaves and continue to contribute over time.
- 4. One modification: use a kindness tree to celebrate the kind acts students are already doing in the classroom (or at home!) Every time you "catch" a student acting in kindness, have them add their action to the tree.
