

Mystery Motivator | Implementation Fidelity Checklist

Rationale: Utilize the Mystery Motivator (MM) intervention to reward students for appropriate behaviors with elements of uncertainty.

Preparation

Step	Did I complete this step? (Yes/No)
Decide when to schedule the intervention (daily, during challenging behaviors).	Yes/No
Define 2-4 target/problem behaviors and match with replacement behaviors.	Yes/No
Calculate a behavior cut-off based on baseline data.	Yes/No
Make a poster of replacement behaviors.	Yes/No
Create the reward envelope with motivating rewards.	Yes/No
