Key Themes of SoR Legislation:

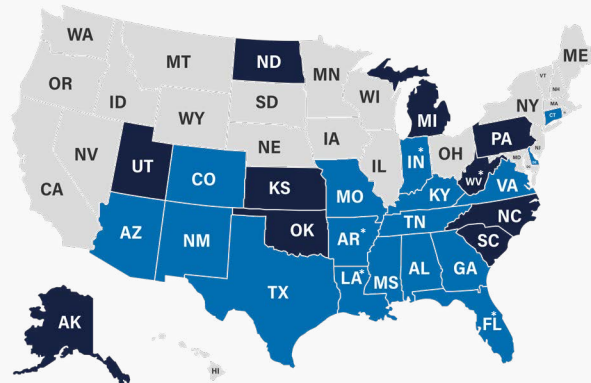
- Provide training on Science of Reading principles
- Administer ongoing evidence-based literacy assessments
- Monitor students' literacy progress and report on development
- Develop comprehensive district literacy plans
- Offer evidence-based literacy instruction
- Implement and track Science of Reading-aligned interventions
- Improve family communication about student literacy plans

Efficiently implementing these requirements will be critical to improving literacy across your schools.
