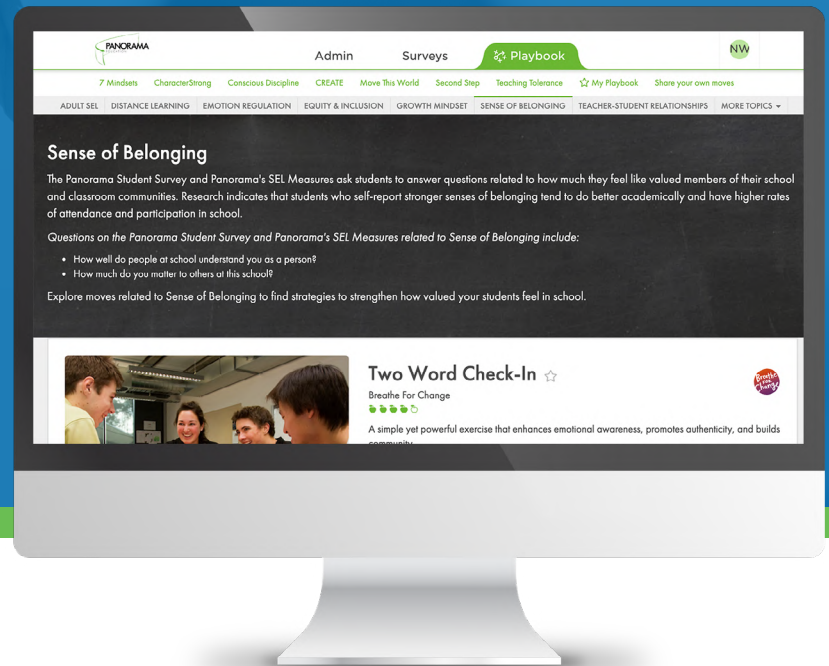

Target specific topics, including Sense of Belonging, Emotion Regulation, Teacher-Student Relationships, Cultural Awareness, and Adult SEL.

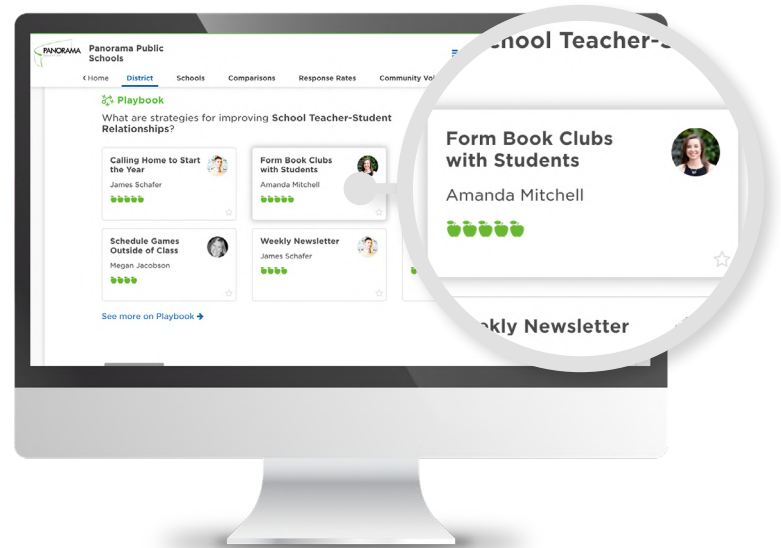
